**FY-06 (period ending June 30, 2006)**

- Complete the pre-feasibility work on the TOT3 project
- Complete the pre-feasibility work on the Bridger-West project
- Complete an economic screening study to identify the next high value transmission corridor project(s) to be pursued
- Complete the business case analysis of any request for funding activities of the Transmission Development Association (i.e., Frontier Line)
- Maintain the viability of the WIA through public policy advocacy, communication and collaboration

**FY-07 (period ending June 30, 2007)**

- If pre-feasibility proven, complete permitting and engineering on the TOT3 project
- If pre-feasibility proven, complete permitting and engineering on the Bridger-West project
- Subject to Board approval, complete pre-feasibility work on next high value transmission corridor project(s) as identified
- Maintain the viability of the WIA through public policy advocacy, communication and collaboration

**FY-08 (period ending June 30, 2008)**

- Finalize contracts with customers, secure financing and acquire rights-of-way for the TOT3 project
- Finalize contracts with customers, secure financing and acquire rights-of-way for the Bridger-West project
- If pre-feasibility proven, complete permitting and engineering on next high value transmission corridor project(s) as identified
